

GLOBAL MOBILE LEADERS HELISKI SUMMIT FAQs

Q: How dangerous is heli skiing? Can anyone do it?

A: See: <http://www.totalheliski.com/is-heliskiing-for-me/> Heliski attendees will need to be able to slide in almost any conditions off trail. There will be limited places for mobile tech leaders who can't yet heliski, for whom resort skiing and other adventure activities will be available. Some of these will be included in the non-heliskier ticket price.

Q: What about liability?

A: All attendees (regardless of heli skiing or not) will be required to sign a waiver from Total Heliski. Heliski attendees will be required to sign the Heliski Operator's waiver also. Total Heliski strongly encourage all attendees to take out special Travel Insurance that covers heli skiing and other unforeseen occurrences. Q: How will the list be curated to ensure the highest calibre of attendees?

A: Total Heliski are preparing the list of invites to go out to various leading non-competing companies in the Mobile Ecosystem including mobile publishers, developers and ad-tech firms. All guests will need to be pre-registered with Total Heliski to obtain an invite before they will be allowed to purchase and confirm their attendance.

Q: What if we can't afford to sponsor all of our guests entry fees to The Summit?

A: Host companies may wish to host all or some of their guests entry fees. We have set up tickets that cover 50% for the event and heliski hosting cost and 50% for the travel and accommodation portion of it.

Q: How do we travel from CES directly to The Heliski Summit?

A: There are two direct flights departing from Las Vegas to Vancouver on January 9th. Both depart at 13:30pm. They are Westjet (1789) and Air Canada (1899). Make sure you are booked on one of those.
